

Van Hoy Oil Indiana/Ohio Shootout Series at Mt Lawn

The Van Hoy Oil Indiana/Ohio shootout series between Mt Lawn Thunder car and Shadybowl Speedway Hobby Stocks will at Mt Lawn Speedway this Sunday June 10.

This will be the second race in the series. The first race was held at Shadybowl Speedway in DeGraff, Ohio last Saturday night and was won by Jason Purtee of DeGraff. Purtee held off A.J. Stewart of Straughn who finished second after leaders Ronnie Rose of Anderson and Dustin Sapp of Indianapolis were forced out with mechanical problems. Earl Adams of Anderson and Jamieson Owens of Greenfield finished third and fourth. Tony Stewart of Straughn didn't compete at Shadybowl because of a wreck at Mt Lawn the week before will have his car ready for action this Sunday.

Adams Enterprises Pro Compacts, Stock Compacts, Cage Karts and State Farm Insurance Street Drags will make up the racing program. Legends originally scheduled for June 10th and July 22nd have been removed from the schedule.

The pit gate will open at 1:30 grandstand and practice opens at 3:30. Qualifications will begin at 5:00 with Gossar's Towing trophy dashes kicking off the racing activity promptly at 6:00. Heat races will be held for the Adams Enterprises Pro Compacts and Stock Compacts. The first feature event of the evening will be the Cage Karts scheduled to begin at 7:15.
