

Bob Fields Memorial 200 this Sunday at Mt Lawn

The Van Hoy Oil CRA Street Stocks will be at Mt Lawn this Sunday afternoon for the running of the Bob Fields Memorial 200 sponsored by Fields Auto Parts in Willow Branch. Joining the Street Stocks will be Thunder Cars sponsored by Van Hoy Oil, Pro Compacts, Stock Front Wheel Drive Compacts and State Farm Street Drags.

The 200 lap event will be the longest race at Mt Lawn since 1995 when Bob Fields came from four laps down early to win the 200 lap Great Survival Run 200. This year's event is shaping up to be a great race with 24 cars already entered with a few more expected. New Castle and Henry County will be well represented in the spectacular with Ryan Amonett, Tyler Hopkins, Jason Thompson, Calvin Parham, Colby Lane, Jason Atkinson, Brian Hopkins, Randy Anderson and Fred Hopkins already entered. Others on the entry list are Jake McElfresh of Elwood, Brandon Burkhardt of Franklin, Dallas Frueh of North Aurora Illinois, James Kirby III of Indianapolis, Thomas Skiles of Indianapolis, Jordon Hahn of Indianapolis, Josh Poore of Anderson, Nathan Green of Muncie, Phil Jenkins of Greenfield, Daniel Adams of Indianapolis, J.J. Schafer of Bremen, Andrew Teepe of Indianapolis Jake Owens of Anderson and Alan Williams Jr of Louisville Kentucky. According to CRA officials they are still waiting on few more drivers to enter.

In the season opener on the May 5th sixteen Indiana/Ohio Shootout Thunder Cars were on hand and the fifty-lap feature race was exciting from start to finish. Five cars battled for the lead the entire race with Jameson Owens of Indianapolis coming out on top. In the Pro Compact division Terry Neal of New Castle won the feature for his sixth win a row. Twelve Pro's started the feature with Alex Abbott of Knightstown giving Neal a run for his money. Twenty seven Stock Front Wheel Drives were in attendance for the opener with Brian Slavey of New Castle coming away with the win.

The pit gate will open 10:00 am on Sunday and the grandstand gate will open at 12:00. Practice will begin at 11:30 with qualifications to start at 1:20. The invocation and National Anthem will be at 2:55 with racing starting at 3:00. A complete schedule of events is available on the Mt Lawn Website and Facebook.
