

Because there are so many different types of Factory Stock Compacts racing it is impossible for any one person to know everything about every model of car participating in an event.

Therefore:

If track officials feel any car is outside the intent of the factory stock compact rules the car will be DQ'd and receive no prize money for the event. If you want to appeal your disqualification you must pay a \$100 appeal fee and your car will be impounded and inspected at our convenience by our technical staff. An appeal decision will be made within 7 days of the event. If the decision is your car is legal you will get your \$100 back plus \$100 inconvenience fee and prize money. If we determine your car is not legal you get your car back but lose winnings, your appeal fee and receive no inconvenience fee. If you get DQ'd and want to appeal just ask yourself "IS MY CAR STOCK".
